# Bringing Resources to Charitable Food Providers



- AAFB secured a grant from United HealthCare, a portion of which will be redistributed through a funding opportunity for food bank member agencies to increase refrigeration capacity
- The AAFB Board approved funds from the AAFB budget to support food bank agencies statewide
- Appropriation was advocated for and included in the Governor's Executive Budget and approved in May 2018. Some of these funds will come to food bank agencies through a funding opportunity to increase the amount of fresh produce distributed through this statewide network.

# More About Funding Opportunities



- First round (UHC and AAFB directed funds) should open in early July. Note: As a condition of receiving funds you need to send as many staff as possible (at AAFB's cost) to online ServSafe training.
- You are eligible to apply if you are an agency of AAFB member food banks (United Food Bank, St. Mary's Food Bank Alliance, Community Food Bank of Southern Arizona, Yuma Community Food Bank).
- If you aren't an agency, your project could be considered if you partner with an organization that is.
- To receive an email when funding opportunities are "open" take one of my business cards and I'll be sure to notify you.
- State funding distribution process is yet to be determined. When we know more we will keep you posted!
