HOW TO SUBMIT ONLINE COMMENTS TO OPPOSE THE *INADMISSIBILITY ON PUBLIC CHARGE GROUNDS* RULE

1. Click www.regulations.gov/document?D=USCIS-2010-0012-0001
2. Click on the [Comment Now](#) button on the top right.
